What I already know
 Christians say following God includes trusting God, obeying God, believing that God promises to stay with them, forgiving others and believing that God will do this too. The Bible is divided into the Old and New Testaments.

Powerful Knowledge

The Old Testament tells the story of a particular group of people, the children of Israel known as the People of God – and their relationship with God.

The people try to live in the way God wants, following his commands and worshipping him. They believe he promises to stay with them and keeps his promises. This can be seen in the story of Noah and Abraham.

God makes a covenant with Noah. People make covenants today e.g. in wedding ceremonies.
