GEOGRAPHY

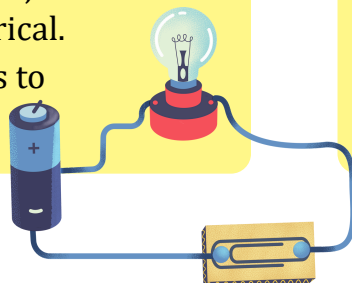
Our Geography topic this half term is Extreme Earth where we will be exploring the layers of the Earth, volcanoes, tornadoes, earthquakes and tsunamis.

PE will be on Thursdays this half term and we will be going swimming on Wednesdays.

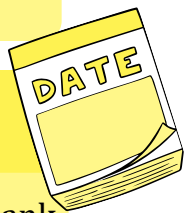
Homework

What are we learning?**MATHS**

In maths we are finishing our fractions work before moving on to decimal learning.
