Our focus in English will be **short stories and narratives** with a focus on Roald Dahl's 'Fantastic Mr. Fox.' We will be looking at the word choices the author uses to create tension and suspense, before using our new vocabulary to create our own stories. After that, we will also look writing our own **animal poems** based on ideas from poem entitled, 'The Bug Chant' by Tony Mitton.

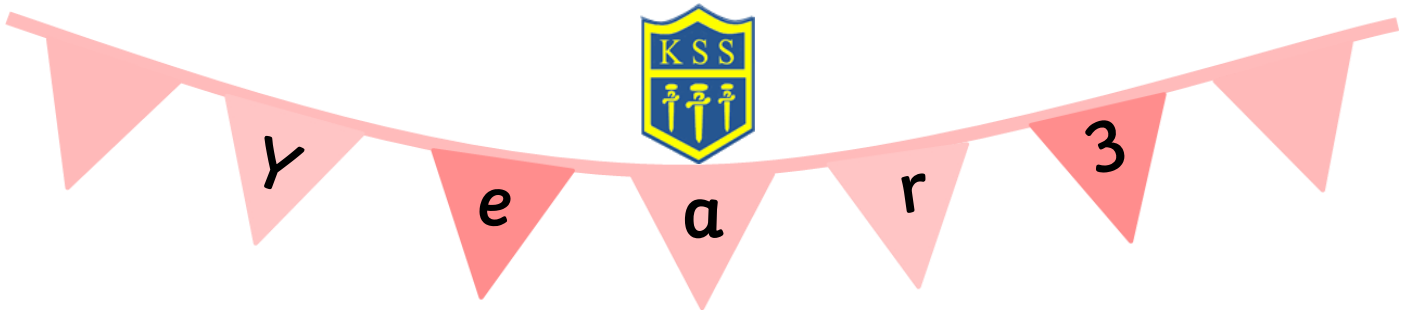
In Maths this half term, we will be learning how to **represent** and **partition** numbers up to 100. We will then be **adding and subtracting** 3-digit numbers using our number bond knowledge to help us add far larger numbers.!

Times tables and numberbonds are **extremely** important in Year 3: **2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s and 8s**. Please use Times Tables Rockstars as much as possible at home to learn all times tables.

In Science, we will be exploring the different types of rocks: metamorphic, igneous and sedimentary and also investigating how fossils are formed. We will then look at how soil is made. Through out this topic, will we be doing a lot of investigations to help us understand some of the rock cooling processes.

Reading is as important as ever in Year 3. We encourage children to **read at home as much as possible** and bring their book and signed reading record in daily. The children will be rewarded every time they read ten times at home. They need to have their reading record signed every time they read and a square from the 100 square coloured in.

In Love to Read, we will begin by reading a non fiction text; **So You Think You've Got It Bad?** In line with our Ancient Egypt topic. We will be move onto reading a poem called 'The River' by Valerie Bloom. We will be focusing on our **prediction, retrieval, summarisation** and **visualisation** skills.



PE is on **Monday and Friday** this half term. Please wear your school PE kit on these days — plain red t-shirt, navy shorts or trousers and black pumps or trainers.

Please ensure your child comes to school with a clean water bottle every day.

In Art and design our focus this term is **drawing Egyptian Art** using different styles, pencil techniques and materials.

Year 3 **homework** will be sent out every week on **Wednesday** and should be returned by the following Wednesday. We will mark homework together in class. **Spellings** will be sent home on **Tuesdays** and will be tested every **Tuesday**. Your child will bring home their spelling test for you to see.
