Phonics

This half term we are learning the following sounds and rules

- 'ear'
- 'ture'
- Adding 'est' and 'y' to words ending in e
- 'mb'
- 'a' and 'al'
- Adding 'ing' and 'ed'

Please make sure your child can read these sounds by the end of this half term.

You could try:

- Making flashcards with these sounds

Love to Read

In Love to Read this half term we are reading the poetry book 'Out and About' by Shirley Hughes and 'The Dancing Tiger' by Malachy Doyle.

You could try:

- Draw a story map of 'The Dancing Tiger'.

These are the foundation subjects we are learning about this half term:

History- Famous Yorkshire Folk

RE- What is God like?

Science- Awe and Wonder

PSHE- Friendship

PE- Fundamentals and Dance

DT- Textiles

Computing- Algorithms and Debugging

Writing

We will be learning to write traditional tales and fables inspired by 'The Frog and the Scorpion' and 'The Ant and the Grasshopper'. We will then move on to writing our own limericks.

You could try:

- Research more fables and tell them to the class.
- Find your favourite poem and read it to the class.

Maths

We will be learning about addition and subtraction with numbers up to 100.

You could try:

- Completing the arithmetic practice on your homework sheet.
- Playing 'Topmarks' games.
