I will be updating our Class Dojo page regularly, please ensure you are connected.

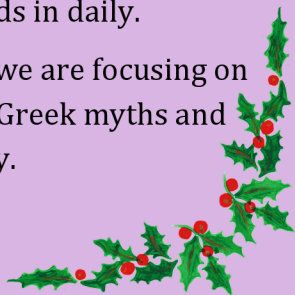
HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY

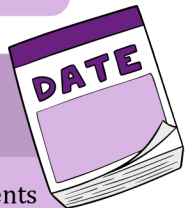
Homework

What are we learning?

MATHS

We will be finding the area of a shape before moving onto multiplication and division.

With our **Times Tables Check** in Spring, we will be practising our times tables as much as possible in class. Please support this at home with regular practise and use of Times Tables Rockstars.

ENGLISH

We will begin by focusing on recounts, studying examples of informal letters and emails before writing our own. After that, we will be exploring poetry with a focus on using figurative language.

SCIENCE

Our topic is states of matter, focusing on solids, liquids and gases and observing how things can change state due to temperature. We will also be learning about the water cycle.

RE

Our key question is 'what are the deeper meanings of festivals?' and we will be studying festivals including Eid-ul-Fitr, Hanukkah and Christmas.

DT

Our focus is Greek Food this half term! We will be exploring flavours, developing safe knife skills and creating our own vegetarian gyros.
