Phonics

This half term we are coming to the end of our phonics scheme.

We will be learning the following prefix:

- 'dis'

We will then be revising the trickiest spelling rules from Year 2.

You could try:

- Making flashcards with these sounds
- Playing spelling games on Top Marks.

Love to Read

In Love to Read this half term we are reading 'The Chocolate Poem' by Michael Rosen and then 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt.

You could try:

- Create a story map for the stories.

Maths

We will be learning about fractions and then learning our 10 times tables!

You could try:

- Completing the arithmetic practice on your homework sheet.
- Playing 'Topmarks' games.
- Playing TT Rockstars

Writing

In writing this half term we will start by writing our own quest stories and then move onto writing poems inspired by 'What is Pink?' by Christina Rossetti

You could try:

- Can you write a story map for your quest story?
- Can you go on a quest with your adult?

These are the foundation subjects we are learning about this half term:

History- How did my parents and grandparents live?

RE- Who is Jewish and how do they live?

Science- Plants

PSHE- Indoors and Outdoors

PE- Dance

DT- Vegetable Salads
