Bake some earthquake cookies. Here's a simple recipe!

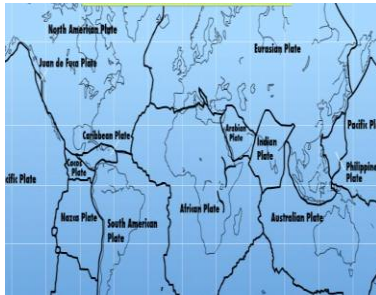
