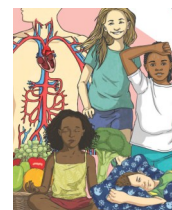

Science

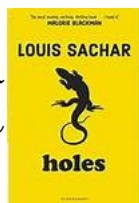
Our new topic this term is **Animals including humans**. In this topic we will be looking at how different organ systems work and learning about the importance of diet, exercise and lifestyle in the way that bodies function. We will learn about the three main parts of the circulatory system and the job of the heart. We will also learn about what blood is comprised of and how it is transported around the body. We will plan and conduct an investigation exploring how heart rate is affected by exercise.



English

In English we will be continuing with our class text of 'Holes' and starting a new class text 'Wonder'. We will be basing our writing on both of these texts but also focussing on our Science topic to write an informative piece of writing all about the circulatory system.

We will also be recapping SPAG terminology ready for the transition to high school.



Maths

This term, we will be conducting many Maths projects all based on things the children will need to understand when becoming an adult! First, we will be learning what a salary is then we will move onto looking at bills and mortgages. Lastly, we will look at planning a holiday using all the Maths skills we have been working on all year!
