Phonics

This half term we are learning the following sounds and rules:

- 'igh'
- 'dge' and 'ge'
- Adding -es' to words ending in 'y'.
- 'gn'
- 'kn'
- Adding -ing and -ed to words ending in 'y'.
- 'wr'
- 'le'

Please practice these sounds with your child so they can read them by the end of this half term.

You could try:

- Making flashcards with these sounds

Love to Read

In Love to Read this half term we are reading a range of fiction and non-fiction short texts.

You could try:

- Introducing your child to some non-fiction texts.

These are the foundation subjects we are learning about this half term:

Geography- Our local environment and fieldwork.

RE- What is the good news that Christians say Jesus brings?

Science- Animals including humans.

PSHE- Being me in my world

PE- Fundamentals and invasion games

Writing

We will be learning to write descriptions and understand the setting of the story 'Not Now Bernard' by David McKee.

We will also be exploring the features of instruction writing so we can confidently write our own set of instructions.

Maths

We will be learning about place value in numbers up to 100 and then moving onto addition and subtraction.

You could try:

- Completing the arithmetic practice on your homework sheet.
- Playing 'Topmarks' games.
