

Welcome to Year 4! We hope you have all had a lovely Summer break.

This term we are going to be exploring the **impact that the Ancient Greeks had on the Western World!** We will be learning about

chronology, religion, archaeology and city states.

Our focus in English will be **Greek myths** which fits in perfectly with our Ancient Greece topic. We will be learning about various myths before writing our own!

We will be recapping previous grammar learning and focusing on both Year 3 and 4 objectives.

In Maths this half term, we will be learning how to **represent** and **partition** numbers up to 10,000. We will then be **rounding** numbers to the nearest 1, 10 and 1,000, before learning about **Roman numerals**! After this, we will move onto extending our Year 3 learning of written methods for **addition and subtraction**.

Times tables are <u>extremely</u> important in Year 4, with a 'Times Tables Check' taking place in Summer Term. Please use Times Tables Rockstars as much as possible at home to learn all times tables.

In Science, we will be exploring the topic of **sound**. We will be exploring **vibrations**, **how we hear sound**, **sound proofing** and then **making music** together!

Reading is as important as ever in Year 4 and we encourage children to **read at home as much as possible** and bring their book and signed reading record in daily. In class we will be playing a game called **Readopoly** where children have the chance to win dojos and prizes every time they read at home.

In Love to Read, we will be reading **Who Let the Gods Out? By Maz Evans.** We will be focusing on our **prediction**, **retrieval**, **summarisation** and **visualisation** skills.



PE is on **Thursdays** this half term. Please wear your school PE kit on this day— plain red t-shirt, navy shorts or trousers and black pumps.

Swimming — We will be going swimming on <u>Wednesdays</u>. Please bring a bag to school that contains a swimming costume/trunks, a towel and goggles if needed.

In Art and design our focus this term is **sculpture**. We will be creating our own Greek vases.

In **Music**, we are very lucky that Mr Jennings will be coming in this half term on **Thursdays**.

Year 4 **homework** will be sent out every week on **Friday** and should be returned by the following Friday. We will mark homework together in class. As this is a full term topic, each child should complete 2 pieces of creative homework before Christmas
