1	Leave spaces between words.
2	Punctuate sentences with a capital letter and full stop.
3	Use capital letters for names of people and the days of the week.
4	Form lower case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.
5	Write simple sentences and sequence to form short narratives.
6	Use 'and' to join clauses.
7	Use question and exclamation marks.
8	Re-read their work to check it makes sense.
9	Spell words using phonemes taught.
10	Spell common exception words and days of the week.
