Key Vocabulary

## What I know already

What people believe in affects the way they live their lives, e.g. Christians, Jewish people, Muslims, Sikhs. They all believe in one God and are therefore theists. There are people who do not follow a religion and choose to live their lives based on reason, not faith. Big Question: Why do some people believe in God and some don't?

## Powerful Knowledge

There are many reasons why people do or don't believe in God. What people believe in is called their world view. Their world view has an impact on how they live their lives. Christians believe in a God who is eternal, omniscient (all-knowing) and omnipotent (all powerful) Few Christians believe because of arguments. Most are Christians because of upbringing or because of their experience of the impact of their faith in their daily living. Many would say they have experienced the presence of God in one way or another through their lives, whether through worship, prayer, celebration, community, or nature, for example.

People who don't believe in God may point to the fact that it is hard to prove God exists, the terrible events in the world make it hard to believe in God. Science has shown how the world was created and so God is not needed.
