Powerful knowledge/skills for this unit:

We will learn about:

The risks associated with using different drugs, including tobacco and nicotine products, alcohol, solvents, medicines and other legal and illegal drugs

- know about some of the possible effects and risks of different drugs
- know that some drugs are restricted or that it is illegal to own, use and supply them to others
- understand why and when people might use drugs

Assessing the level of risk in different situations involving drug use

- can explain why risk depends on the drug itself, the person using the drug and the situation – when and where the person is, and who they are with
- can identify risks within a given scenario involving drug use
- understand what would need to change to reduce the level of risk

ways to manage risk in situations involving drug use

- can identify situations where drug use may occur
- know some ways of reducing risk in situations involving drug use
- know where to get help, advice and support regarding drug use

What should I already know:

The about different influences on drug use –alcohol, tobacco and nicotine products

Big Question:

Can you talk about some of the possible side effects of drugs?

The end point: Know where can people get advice or help?

Be able to describe how a person might think about the level of risk in a situation involving drug use
